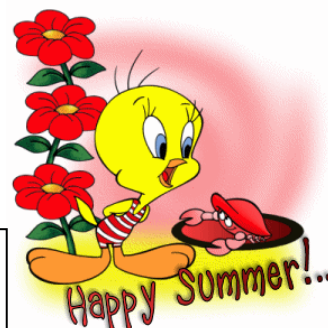
### **Kindergarten Registration 2017-2018**
